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Tour a \$14.75 Million Loft in SoHo

This four-bedroom, four-bathroom home offers immaculate amenities *and* a private garden oasis

Located in the historic NYC neighborhood of [SoHo](#)—a shopping and dining mecca for cityfolk and travelers alike—150 Wooster’s Loft 2 is the last full-floor unit to be released in this ultra coveted building.

The four-bedroom, four-bathroom property has more outdoor space than any other unit in the building (except the penthouse), with a beautiful private landscaped garden and an outdoor kitchen. It also features loft-like interiors, inspired by the homes of local artists from the 60s and 70s. The keyed elevator opens directly into a private entry gallery and the chef’s kitchen consists of a Danby marble island, countertops, and cabinet faces, state-of-the-art appliances, and a large walk-in pantry. The master bathroom is also complete with a custom Danby marble vanity, Danby marble mosaic floors, a 6-foot soaking tub and a separate water closet. A laundry room and three additional bedrooms and bathrooms complete the living quarters.

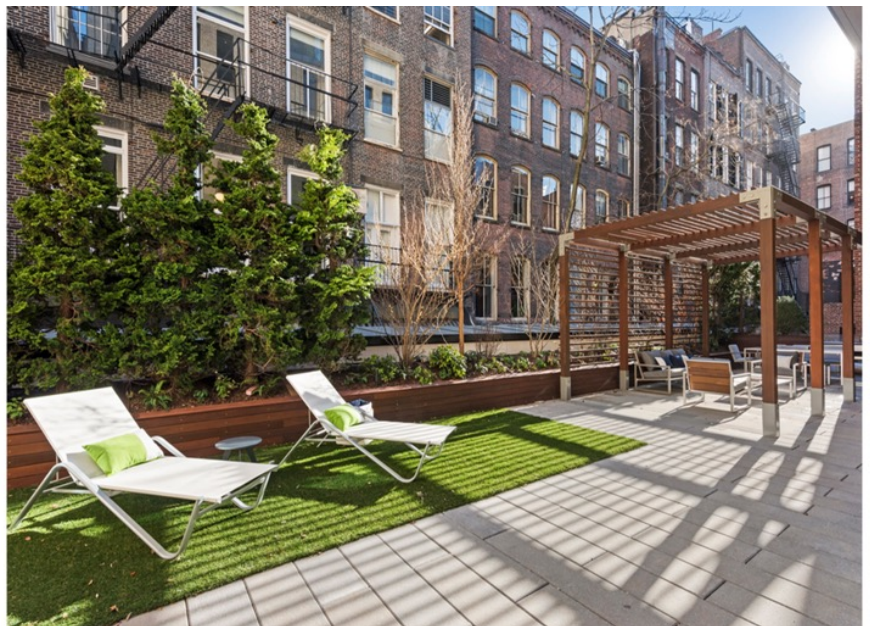
