Ultra-modern Cobble Hill townhouses hit the market

Three units at ultra-modern Cobble Hill townhouse 253 Pacific Street have hit the market with relatively high price tags for the borough, Brownstoner reported. The three apartments — which features dark wood and sleek features, according to Brownstoner — are listed for \$2.6 million, \$2.4 million and \$2.15 million, respectively.

The first is a three-bedroom penthouse duplex with a terrace and outdoor kitchen. The \$2.4 million home is a four-bedroom duplex with a balcony; the last unit is a three-bedroom garden duplex. Those prices put the homes not totally out of range of Brooklyn's priciest townhouses.

The project began construction in April 2011 and was designed by James Cleary Architecture, according to previous reports from Brownstoner. [Brownstoner] — Guelda Voien
